Honour the Earth is an ideal piece for Festivals & whole school performances including massed choirs. It includes world music influences from Africa, Native America, Aboriginal & Mongolia (overtone singing). Given the importance of the environment its theme is contemporary & timely.

• for Treble or Mixed voice choir a cappella or accompanied (by Full Orchestra or Concert Band, String Orchestra, or Cello Ensemble).

Note: The accompaniment includes Harmonic Whirlies (B5 & B6) & optional Didgeridoo ('B')

Past Life Melodies is Sarah Hopkins' most well known choral piece to date. It's the most performed Australian choral piece in the world!

Past Life Melodies is "a profound musical work which blends European antiquity with Aboriginal songlines and then transports one to Nepal, the roof of the world, where the monks are chanting". (Stuart Phillpot).

This iconic piece embraces several vocal techniques not traditionally used in Western choral music, namely open-throated chant singing, Aboriginal inspired chant and harmonic overtone singing.

The accompaniment versions work very well, featuring the Harmonic Whirlies in the final section, plus optional Didgeridoo (in 'B')

There have been many large scale performances of **Past Life Melodies**. It was performed as part of the Opening Ceremony of the Pan Pacific School Games, in the Sydney Olympic Stadium by massed school choir of 7,000 students with orchestra. **Past Life Melodies** was also performed at the Sixth World Symposium of Choral Music in Minneapolis in 2002.

3) *Return to Joy* (1995) approx 4 mins

• for Treble or Mixed Voices a cappella or accompanied (by any Treble ensemble).

Return to Joy is a jubilant celebration of life in song. This piece reflects Sarah's love of world music, particularly African chants. In **Return to Joy** floating crystalline chords pave the way for two chant melodies: a joyous 'forest song' which seems to literally 'dance' over the top of the sustained chords & later an 'earthly chant melody' fully of power & vigour. These two chants gradually interweave & interlock creating a vibrant joyous ending, which fades into the ether.

4) Hullayha (2003/04)

• for SA divisi or SATB divisi choir a cappella or accompanied (by optional percussion, String Orchestra or Full Orchestra).

Hullayha (pronounced "hull—ay —ha") was originally part of a 30 minute selection of pieces composed by Sarah during 2003 for choir & orchestra "**Childers Shining"**. She made this arrangement in 2004.

Sarah writes: "The opening melody of **Hullayha** sang through me late one night after I prayed to be uplifted to the highest level of Divine Love. I discovered later from a Jewish friend that the word 'a-le-ha' means 'blessings on her'. As the piece unfolds the soulful opening gradually transforms into abundant joy with chimes ringing in joyous celebration".

The optional percussion parts are for tambourine, concert chime bars & Djembe (or any 2 toned drum).

- 6) Tinka Linka (from 3 Songs from Childers Shining) (2003) 1' 30"

Tinka Linka is a very playful, joyous song of childlike innocence & delight. It celebrates the devas, the nature spirits! The choir sings in soul language "Tinka Linka, Coombyeeah".... meaning Tinka Linka (nature spirit) come by here!" This is an ideal piece for Primary school choirs.

The optional accompaniment part is for keyboard (Vibraphone sound), 4 Harmonic Whirlies (F5, G5, F6 & G6), Concert bar chimes & Djembe (or any 2 toned drum).

 - for Mixed Voices SATB divisi a cappella or accompanied (by String Orchestra & Tubular Bell).

Lament is a scored for two choirs, staged to sing in clear antiphonal call & response. A baritone soloist (or small group or male signers) is also required.

Sarah writes: Lament was birthed during a deep healing process. I had the flu and was led to voice and release all the grief I'd ever felt & the grief of humanity also... the horrors of war, torture, starvation & the senseless loss of life. Through expressing the grief it was released, which in turn led to healing and upliftment.

In *Lament* the two choirs journey this healing path, one singing a 'grief chant' interspersed with a solo baritone's plaintive recitative, the other responding like a choir of Angels "Let it go..." Gradually, both choirs units in an uplifting melody, which leads to an ascending musical staircase representing healing, transformation & upliftment.

Ancient Forests Once Stood Here is a powerful new piece which evokes the Dreamtime Spirit of Australia. Inspired by a clairvoyant's vision this piece includes the celestial sounds of the Harmonic Whirlies, the earthy drones of the Didgeridoo together with lyrical & triumphant melodies from the choir, plus harmonic overtone singing. It can be performed with or without String Orchestra.

Many Lives, Many Songs employs the celestial sounds of the Harmonic Whirlies together with vocal 'toning', Irish inspired melodies, a pygmy-like chant & harmonic overtone singing. It was commissioned by Vox Femina Los Angeles & premiered in March 2008.
